Catamount Constructors Awarded Faith-Based Renovation Project

EVERGREEN, Colorado – Evergreen-based builder **Catamount Constructors, Inc. (CCI)** is awarded the Christ the King Catholic Church renovation and expansion project located at 4291 Evergreen Parkway in Evergreen, Colorado. A parish of the Archdiocese of Denver, Christ the King's renovation project includes complex site work consistent with mountain construction. The demolition phase is scheduled to begin early August with an anticipated total project completion date of March 2010.

The 17,000 square foot construction project will consist of the demolition of the existing youth center, parish hall and kitchen, challenging site work and the erection of a new facility adjoining the existing church structure. The new addition will include a lobby, parish hall, classrooms, kitchen, youth center, administrative offices and miscellaneous special purpose rooms. Once complete, the new facilities will be more readily accessible to the entire Evergreen community, enhancing its already abundant philanthropic base.

With 2008 revenues exceeding \$226 million, Catamount is a privately held commercial general contractor with offices in Evergreen, Colorado and Atlanta, Georgia. This builder provides contracting services to owners and developers nationwide with services that include general contracting, construction management, LEED construction, design-build, cost estimating, conceptual budgeting, scheduling and value engineering. Markets served include faith-based, retail, hospitality / restaurant, multi-family, LEED / sustainable, industrial, medical / corporate office and automotive.

"Even though Catamount has a 12 year history of constructing faith-based facilities nationwide, we feel particularly proud of our association with Christ the King Catholic Church. To have the opportunity to renovate a parish that is located in our small mountain home town is uniquely gratifying," said Kurt Kenchel, CCI Vice President / Principal. "Christ the King's Pastor, Father Christopher Kenner is passionate about serving his parishioners and the entire Evergreen community and we feel extremely privileged to have the occasion to be part of his vision and commitment," Kenchel added.

Founded as a parish in 1932, Christ the King Catholic Church has undergone remarkable growth over the past 85 years with the assistance of multiple donors and strong leadership. The parish has grown from 150 households in 1951 to over 1,100 households today. The existing parish hall was built in 1956. The first parish council, formed in 1968, conducted a fund drive for a new church and education center and after pledges reached \$88,000 in 1970, ground was broken for a new worship facility. Archbishop Casey blessed the new church on May 24, 1971. Surrounded by ponderosa trees, the full-service parish center has remained to this day in the multi-level complex built around the new rustic moss rock church.
